

How to Play Three Card Poker

Three Card Poker® is an exciting stud poker game with three ways to play and four different ways to win.

Bet against the dealer, on the value of your own three-card hand or bet both. Bonus payouts may be had for certain hands when wagering against the dealer.

To play against the dealer, place an ante wager. After looking at your three-card hand you may fold, or if you think your hand beats the dealer, place an equal wager on the play spot. If your hand beats the dealer's qualifying hand of a queen or better, you win both wagers! If the dealer doesn't qualify, you win the ante wager and the play wager is a push.

When wagering against the dealer, the following bonuses will be paid:

Ante Bonus Payouts	
Straight	1:1
3 of a Kind	4:1
Straight Flush	5:1

Playing Against the Dealer	
Player Folds	Lose Wagers
Dealer does not qualify	Play bet is pushed; Ante wins 1:1
Dealer qualifies and Player's Play bet wins	Play bet wins 1:1
Player's hand beats Dealer's hand and Ante wins	1:1
Player and Dealer tie	Bets are pushed

To play the hand value only (not against the dealer), place a wager on the pair plus spot. If your hand contains a pair or better, you win.

When wagering a Pairs Plus Bet, the following will be paid:

Pair	1:1
Flush	4:1
Straight	5:1
3 of a Kind	30:1
Straight Flush	40:1

To play both, bet the ante and pair plus spots. You must make a play wager if you have placed the ante, or forfeit the ante and pairs plus.
