

Checklist for Plein Air Painting

- Paint (Option one or two—see lists below)
- Acrylic glazing medium
- Easel—portable, sturdy, easy to carry and set up
- Rags
- Brushes assorted sizes, You need both stiff and soft brushes
- Strippable palette pad
- Palette knife
- Water container, one to transport water in.
- Water cup or plastic container
- Grocery bags for trash, transporting wet brushes
- Sketch book and B pencil
- 6 -8 Panels/canvases to paint on (Sizes: 8x10 or 9 x 12)
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Layered clothing
- Sturdy shoes/boots
- Camera
- Water for you to drink
