

Danielle Gibson—Youth Workshop Session

The Youth Workshop runs two days, from 9:30 to 3:30 (with lunch provided) Saturday and Sunday. The youth participating are invited to be guests at the Conference Dinner Saturday night.

The Youth Workshop tuition is \$50. Students unable to afford the tuition may apply for a waiver. Tuition includes the two-day workshop, lunch each day and the Saturday night Conference Dinner.

The Workshop is by prior admission only. There are only fourteen positions available. The positions will be distributed in the following geographical manner—two from Elkford, two from Sparwood, four from Fernie (two from Fernie Secondary and two from Fernie Academy), and the remaining six from Cranbrook.

Applicants are to submit up to four pages of writing—poetry, fiction or non-fiction and a letter of recommendation from a teacher familiar with their work and an completed registration with a parental/guardian signature. Submissions should be in standard manuscript format.

1. A cover page with applicant's name, address and contact information
2. Single sided 8.5 x 11 white paper
3. 12-point serif type—New Times Roman or similar
4. One inch margins all around
5. Double spaced

For poetry, same conditions with the consideration to retain the formatting--single space stanzas, double space between stanzas. One inch margin on the left, top and bottom.

Applications are due in hard copy (no electronic submissions) by April 6, 2018 at St. Eugene Resort by 5PM. Notification of admission and waiting lists will be announced on April 13, 2018. All applicants will be notified of the results.
